IMIS/"Athena" RC takes part in the SECOVIA Transnational Exchange Experience Workshop on Cloud Computing in Győr

Athens, September 12, 2014

In early September 2014 the third SECOVIA Transnational Experience Exchange Workshop on Cloud Computing were held in Győr, Hungary.

The event was organized by Pannon Novum and its objective was on the one hand to promote the use of cloud computing solutions by the public sector and highlight of its benefits and on the other to facilitate the exchange of ideas, practices and solutions on shared IT services and infrastructures for territorial administrations.

There a comprehensive system of hybrid cloud infrastructure was presented in practice as well as some examples of good practice from various business verticals. The event aimed at government officials, business people and those who are in the process of decision regarding private or leased facilities.

SECOVIA partners from five different countries were present making possible the trans-border exchange of experiences and ideas. IMIS following its participation in the respective preceding events in Ljubljana and Sarajevo IMIS was once again present and represented by Mr. Thodoris Stratiotis.

During the Transnational Experience Exchange Workshop IMIS' representative presented the state of the art in Greece highlighting the relative national strategies and initiatives launched. They also argued on the feasibility of jointly established cloud provider serving the needs of the PAs of the region. Furthermore he was involved in discussions with the local audience on the current situation regarding the adoption of cloud by Public Authorities, businesses and ordinary citizens in the South East Europe region. Common policy and organizational problems were identified and solutions were suggested.
